Examples of Purchases Requiring Pre-Approval:

- Routine or non-urgent vet visits
- Medications or supplements
- Dog food and treats
- Fleas/tick/worm treatments
- Leads, collars, harnesses, bedding, toys, and other essentials

Emergency veterinary care (e.g., injury, sudden illness) does not require prior approval.

Please notify the President as soon as possible following any emergency treatment.
